## Create inclusive spaces from innovative solutions:

- ① 360-degree turning spaces energize workflow productivity in offices and work spaces
- ② Proper ceiling heights and dividers provide optimal acoustics, with floor plans designed to promote communication and social interactions
- ③ Work stations easily adjust to provide the choice to sit or stand
- ④ Stairs have extra safety features, such as multiple handrail heights and contrasting colored edges, that prevent falls and help improve visibility
- ⑤ Food services areas have appliances, counters, tray slides, buffets, tableware and accompaniment stations that are easy to reach for all
- ⑥ Nursing rooms are separated from toilet and bathrooms, and have amenities that provide families with a private and comfortable space
- ⑦ Single-user toilet rooms are available for all genders and assisted use
- ⑧ Signs use multiple formats, including pictograms, to clearly convey a room's purpose
- ⑨ Prevalent and adjustable lighting in all rooms, including natural daylight, provides illumination customized to personal needs
- ⑩ Spacious elevators allow people who use wheeled mobility devices, strollers, carts, etc. to turn around and avoid crowding
